## Student Requirements

- In High School during year of visit (2017)
- On track for graduation/good academic standing
- Minimum 2.3 GPA
- Faculty input/recommendations

## The Process

### Tickets

- Price/schedule available: 2017
- Deposit date: TBD (\$150 per traveler)
- Final commitment deadline: ~3 months prior to travel (no refunds after this time)
- Final payment due: ~6 weeks before travel



### Visas

- Required for entry to China
- Applications closer to travel time (~3 months prior)

## The Process

### Passports

- Required for international travel
- Minimum of 6 months validity from the date of arrival in China required for travel to China
- Apply 6 months before travel
- Families take care of passport applications
