## Targeted Feedback Cycles Blending Coaching and Evaluation

This professional learning event highlights a **targeted feedback cycle observation and evaluation system** based on **objective data, reflection, collaborative conversation, and focused coaching**. The teacher and observer collaboratively engage in a **strengths-based approach** to identify a small shift in a focused area of instructional practice that will **yield significant gains in student achievement**. The professional learning becomes specific to the individual educator and occurs in the day-to-day interactions with students within the classroom.

**Research in Action** days assist classroom teachers and educational leaders in **thinking deeply about their instructional practice**. A unique professional learning experience, participants directly **observe teaching practice, interview teachers** about their approaches, and **learn new strategies**.
