Dear Parents/Guardians,

We are pleased to announce the Memorial Rosa Rabell Spanish Language Study Scholarship, named in honor of P.K. Yonge's retired Spanish language teacher, the beloved Señora Rosa Rabell.

This is a wonderful opportunity for a deserving P.K. Yonge student to study the Spanish language and culture in Costa Rica this summer. The student will stay with a host family and will participate in an immersion program to expand their knowledge of the Spanish Language. This experience includes airfare, transportation, housing, regional-style meals, guided sightseeing, entrances to museums, and more. Students will be responsible for obtaining a passport, providing meal money including tips, and funds for personal expenses.

Eligibility:

The P.K. Yonge student must:

- Be at least 16 years old.
- Have completed a minimum of two years of Spanish study.
- Have a minimum 3.0 unweighted GPA.
- Have carried a minimum 3.0 average in his or her current Spanish class.
- Students who can prove financial need will be given special consideration.
- Seniors and students who have not taken Spanish are not eligible.

Enrollment and Application Deadline: Students are asked to:

- Obtain approval and application from Sra. Santiago, Spanish teacher.
- Submit the application and parental waiver, along with
 - a one-page essay (in English): *My Thoughts on the Benefits of Studying Spanish*
 - (1) letter of recommendation from a P.K. Yonge teacher
 - (2) letters of recommendation from contacts not employed by P.K. Yonge
- Submit application and attachments to Sra. Santiago, P.K. Yonge Developmental Research School, 1080 SW 11th Street, Gainesville, FL 32601 before October 11, 2019.
