

Important Information Regarding Virtual Instruction 2020-21

- Virtual courses taken during the school day are part of the P. K. Yonge Virtual School Franchise. P. K. Yonge contracts with Florida Virtual School for these courses.
- During course registration, students may request up to one credit to be taken during the school day for the 2020-21 school year.
- A signed contract must be submitted to complete registration for a virtual course.
- Registration for a virtual course for the 2020-21 school year must be completed by Friday, July 24, 2020.
- Should a student complete an entire credit (2 segments) by Friday, December 18, 2020, the student will have the option to register for an additional virtual course for second semester.
- Segment 1 must be completed by Friday, December 18 to continue in the course for second semester. Should a student fail to meet this deadline, the student's schedule will be adjusted, and the student will be registered into a P. K. Yonge face-to-face course for second semester.
- Failure to complete a virtual course will require administrative approval for future enrollment in virtual courses.

- Because of the structure of the middle school academic program, students may only choose elective courses as a virtual option during the school day.
