WHAT WE ARE LEARNING:

Reading:

- 4th grade families-

Math:

- 4th grade families-
 - 4th graders have ventured into the magical land of subtracting large numbers. We used place value disks to show regrouping today. Students should remember that we can never subtract backwards, even if it seems easier to do so.
- 5th grade families-
 - 5th graders have been doing long division with estimation techniques. We've been using partial quotients to zero in on our final answers, and we've checked our work by multiplying the

divisor by the quotient and adding the remainder to see if it matches the dividend.

Science:

- 4th and 5th grade families-
 - We are making constellation posters this week. Check out SeeSaw in the coming days for pictures of our work. Students are making the posters and then placing them around the room to make a physical model of where they are in relation to the sun.
