Just a Note:

This week we learned about our community. We talked about the important members of our PKY community and our larger Gainesville community. We discussed ways to take care of others and how others take care of us!

What we're learning:

Kindergarten: This week we read the book *The Alphabet*; we learned that we can tell a story even if there are no words. We also worked on singing familiar songs and finding rhyming words in poems. We also worked on becoming more independent at Word Work; we practiced using different school tools to build our names and practice our letters. In Writing, we drew and labeled pictures about what we love about school; our class list of what we love were so long! In Math, we learned that numbers can be made of smaller numbers: 5 can be 2 and 3 or 4 and 1. We also practiced writing our numbers the school way. It has been a great week in Kindergarten!

First Grade: We read a fable about three frogs and discussed the story's message. Using the story, we learned the vocab words quarrel, rumble, tremble and peaceful. We continued to practice building our independent working stamina during literacy workshops. For math, we finished our first module and used doubles to add efficiently. Be on the lookout for our new math workbook! We discussed ways to be a responsible citizen at school and home, and began celebrating Hispanic Heritage Month!
