 - a. take AP English Language and Composition as their ELA requirement
 - b. experience SAT/ACT Test Prep seminar
- Students entering 10th grade in 2023-24 will
 - a. experience pre-AP coursework
- Students entering 10th-12th grade in 2023-24 may
 - a. elect AP Pre-Calculus as a replacement to Pre-Calculus honors (in consideration)
