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## UF DUAL ENROLLMENT

- Eligible students gain access to UF courses delivered **100% online or on campus**
- Satisfy **general education** requirements and/or explore new subject areas through **challenging electives**
- Take up to two courses each fall and spring semester at **no cost to the student**
- UF Dual Enrollment credits can be combined with advanced placement coursework to help define your path towards a future college degree





## ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Junior or Senior standing
- **3.6** cumulative unweighted GPA
- Qualifying test scores
  - SAT: **1100**
  - PSAT (10/NMSQT only): **1130**
  - ACT: **22**

- Face to face undergraduate level courses

- Course availability is not guaranteed—have back up options that work with your high school schedule!
- Students register themselves during a special window 10 days before classes begin

- Self-Register after advising with our office during the special window 10 days before classes begin for upcoming term
- Independent, no grade tracking with face to face classes
- Must be able to attend lectures in person at the various times listed in the SOC in addition to the final exam during exam week
