# WHAT TIME IS REQUIRED TO GRADUATE?

## Attendance Matters!

### Absences:

- 10 Unexcused absences results in attendance contract
- 6 excused absences with parent note
- Doctor's notes are excused
- 10 Unexcused absences in second semester prevent students from participating in end of year events including prom.



### Tardies:

- 4 unexcused tardies equals one unexcused absence

# Graduating with Honors

We like to stress that honors are AWARDED your senior year but EARNED through the entire high school experience. If you want cords, stoles and sashes to wear at graduation and write about in your senior resume and scholarship essays, you must be working every day toward that goal.

4.2-5.0 weighted GPA

## **High Honors:**

3.8-4.19 weighted GPA

# Talented Twenty

Students eligible for the Talented Twenty Program have proven academic success in their public high school and are **guaranteed admission, within space and fiscal limitations, to one of the twelve state universities.**

Students must be in the top 20% of the class after the posting of the 7<sup>th</sup> semester (1<sup>st</sup> semester of senior year) and must have met all the 19 prep credits as specified by the State Board of Education Rules.

  - | Credit in a course = rigorous to Chemistry or Physics

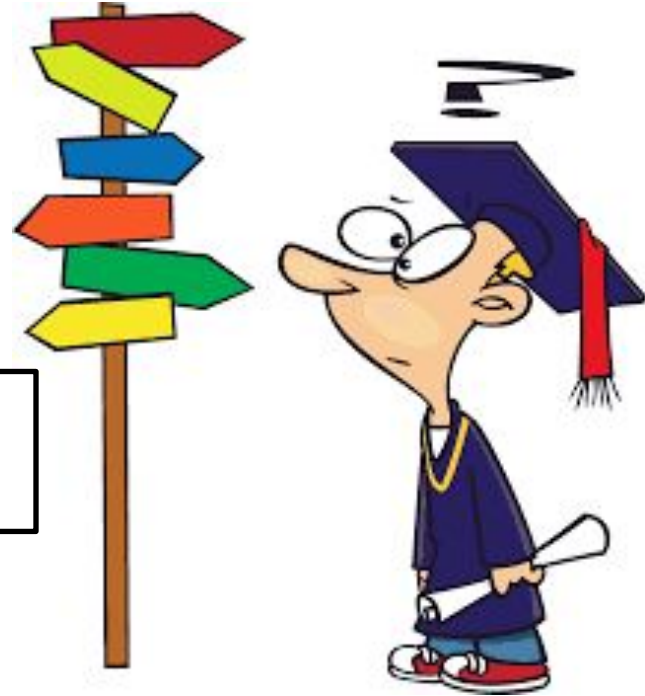

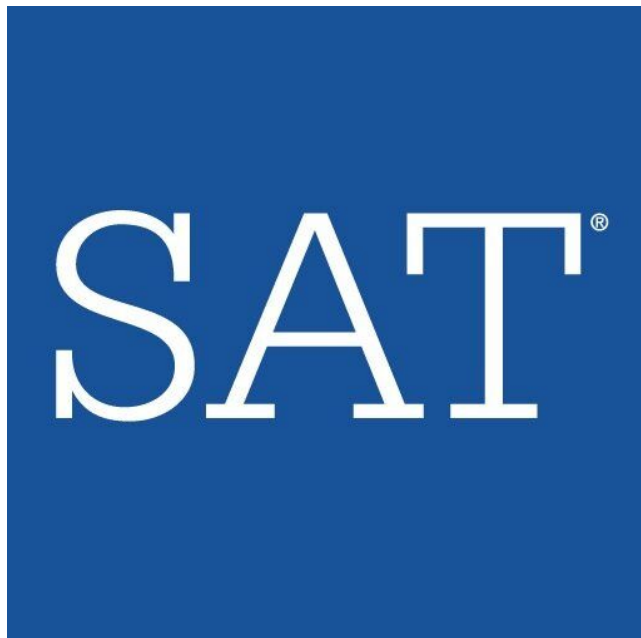
