- Focusing on 2 new efforts:
  - Subcommittee set with goal to recommend/establish expectations for teacher inquiry
  - Determine best way to evaluate the 4X4 block scheduling change
- Other item on the radar: distribution of recognition funding as result of PKY being an “A” school

## **SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN DISCUSSION – Ross Van Boven**

- State of FL encourages all schools to submit School Improvement Plans (SIP) but only requires SIP for schools with “D” or “F” grades – PKY is an “A” school
- Looking at last year’s data – one subgroup performed below benchmark: Students with disabilities (3<sup>rd</sup> year in a row for this subgroup)
- Our current supports: SLPs, subject coaches, etc.
- Added supports this year: subject area specialists and tutors
- Would like to focus on the students with disabilities subgroup for our SIP this year
