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

- **Florida Academic Scholars (FAS)** covers **100% of tuition and fees** at a Florida public university, along with a \$300 stipend for books and supplies.
- Florida Medallion Scholars (FMS) covers 75% of tuition and fees at a Florida public university, with a \$300 stipend for books and supplies.
- **Florida Gold Seal Vocational Scholars (GSV)** covers tuition for eligible vocational programs, including up to 60 credit hours at a community college or technical school.

Florida Bright Futures Scholarship Program



Florida Academic Scholars (FAS):

- 3.50 weighted GPA
- 100 volunteer service hours, 100 paid work hours, or a combination of 100 total hours
- 29 ACT/95 CLT/1330 SAT

Florida Medallion Scholars (FMS):

- 3.00 weighted GPA
- 75 volunteer service hours, 100 paid work hours, or a combination of 100 total hours
- 24 ACT/82 CLT/1190 SAT

Florida Gold Seal Vocational Scholars (GSV):

- 3.00 weighted GPA in non-elective courses
- 3 full credits in a single Career and Technical Education program
- 3.5 unweighted GPA in a single Career and Technical Education program
- 30 volunteer service hours, 100 paid work hours, or a combination of 100 total hours
