AP Microeconomics 2025-2026

AP Microeconomics is an introductory college-level microeconomics course. Students cultivate their understanding of the principles that apply to the functions of individual economic decision-makers by using principles and models to describe economic situations and predict and explain outcomes with graphs, charts, and data as they explore concepts like scarcity and markets; costs, benefits, and marginal analysis; production choices and behavior; and market inefficiency and public policy.

To succeed in this course requires:

- Strong Logical and Critical Thinking
 - a. Be able to interpret, explain, and apply economic reasoning with accurate terminology and diagrams.
- Graphing and Mathematical Skills
 - a. Be comfortable with drawing and interpreting graphs
- Basic Algebra
 - a. Be able to solve for unknowns and do basic arithmetic.
 - b. Understand and apply percentage changes, ratios, and marginal calculations.
- Test-Taking and Time Management Learn how to manage time effectively on multiple choice and FRQs.
 - a. Practice with past exams to get familiar with question patterns and difficulty.
