#### Director's Update

- Gym Update Approved by BOT to being construction on the new gym
  - \$18million budget
  - \$12million awarded by the state
  - Proposal to identify funding sources for the other costs including use of other state funds that have been encumbered over the past few years for capital projects
  - Met with contractors last week, short-list meeting set for May
  - Hope to have final contracts signed by end of June
- Teacher Travel Budget Updates
  - \$42,919 funds spent so far this year out of the \$50,000 allocated to travel
  - Will need to diligently watch the outgoing costs in the coming year
  - Met with faculty council to discuss changes to the faculty travel policies
    - \$30,000 total budget next year (\$22,000 in Fall, and \$8,000 in Spring)
    - \$800 for In-State Travel
    - \$1.500 for Out-of-State Travel
    - TDE to be submitted to the principal
    - Travel Awards can only be awarded 3 years in a row
    - Faculty will be limited to one travel award per year
    - Travel support with multiple PKY faculty presenters will be limited to two PKY faculty members
    - Faculty must share a brief summary of the conference they attend at the next SAC Meeting
  - o Suggestion proposed to update the faculty travel policy document to include
