

American Sycamore

Platanus occidentalis

- *The Sycamore is a massive tree reaching **75 to 90 feet in height**, making it one of the largest trees in that can be found in North America.*
- *It has a **rapid growth rate**, and tolerates **wet and compacted soil**; its grey-brown bark peels off in patches, revealing a smooth **ghostly white inner layer**—one of the tree’s most distinguishable traits.*
- *It has **large leaves**, each with three to five **lobes**, edges that are like saw teeth, and a **fuzzy underside**.*
