

Bluff Oak

Quercus austrina

- This North American **native** oak is found all over Florida and is distinguishable by its **full canopy**, **scaly** gray-brown bark, and abundance of **small acorns**.
- The green, **4-8 inch long leaves** are narrow with shallow, rounded, irregular lobes and are **deciduous** but **do not change color** before dropping in fall.
- Their small acorns, **less than one-inch**-long, follow their green, spring **flowers**.
- The trunk often grows **straight up** with branches that are **well-spaced** along it.
