- *A member of the **Hickory** family, the Pignut Hickory is common throughout the Southeastern United States.*
- *Producing edible fruit, the **pignut hickory nut** is not as popular as the other members in its family, such as the pecan and walnut, but has been widely used in earlier times as a food source for **native people** in this region.*
- ***Hickory wood** is highly **desired** for its hardness, and is commonly used to make furniture, tool handles, as firewood, and for different cooking purposes.*
