

Shumard Oak

Quercus shumardii

- *Part of the red oak family, the Shumard Oak is one of the largest of the red oak species in the Southeast, spanning across much of the region.*
- *This tree is desirable both for its beauty and size as a shade tree and for its high lumber quality.*
- *These trees are commonly planted across towns and cities, and in the fall and winter show off a vibrant color change before losing their leaves.*
- *The Shumard oak also produces large acorns, which help easily identify if there is a Shumard Oak in the area.*
