Magnolia grandiflora

- *Southern Magnolias can be distinguished by their large, glossy, dark green leaves that are brown and fuzzy on the bottom.*
- *They produce bright red seeds that pop out of a cone-like fruit known as a Follicetum.*
- *They are known for their large, fragrant white flowers, which have a unique arrangement found in early angiosperms (flowering plants).*
- *The genus Magnolia honors French biologist Pierre Magnol, and its species *grandiflora* means “big flower” in Latin.*
