

Tulip Poplar

Liriodendron tulipifera

- *Not a true poplar, a family which contains species such as the famous Quaking Aspen (*Populus tremuloides*), as well as willows and cottonwood trees.*
- *The Tulip Poplar is most closely related to the Magnolia family, characterized by large flowering trees, which can be seen both in the Southern Magnolia and the Tulip Poplar.*
- *Tulip Poplar is also known to produce massive amounts of cotton-like pollen in the spring, and when in larger strands containing multiple trees, it resembles snow when it falls.*
